

FORT BEND COUNTY A&M UNIVERSITY MOTHERS' CLUB SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

PURPOSE:

The Fort Bend County A&M University Mothers' Club Scholarship Program seeks to recognize and reward Texas A&M University students who:

- are proficient in academics
- are involved in purposeful activities outside the classroom with emphasis on campus-sponsored organizations, leadership and service
- demonstrate a commitment to help fund their own college education

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicant must be a resident of Fort Bend County with a permanent mailing address within Brazos ISD, Fort Bend ISD, Kendleton ISD, Lamar Consolidated ISD, Needville ISD or Stafford MSD.
2. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen as defined by the U. S. Department of Education criteria for receiving federal financial assistance.
3. Applicant must have a minimum overall GPR of 2.50.
4. Applicant must be a current, full-time undergraduate student at Texas A&M University College Station, Galveston or Blinn TEAM enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours at time of application and classified as a sophomore, junior or senior student in good standing for the fall semester following the award. Students in 5-year undergraduate degree programs are eligible in the fifth year.
5. Incoming freshman students are not eligible to receive a scholarship but may apply during their freshman year for a scholarship to be used the following year provided they have achieved sophomore classification.
6. Blinn TEAM students with a minimum GPR of 3.0 may apply their freshman or sophomore year for a scholarship to be used the following year provided they are transitioning to Texas A&M University.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

1. The scholarship award is a fixed amount determined by the Board of Directors and is to be applied to normal tuition and fees.
2. The duration of the scholarship is for the scholastic year beginning no later than the fall semester following the award. One-semester seniors in the final year of a 4-year or 5-year undergraduate degree program shall receive 100% of their allotted scholarship for the fall semester provided that they will graduate following said semester.
3. The scholarship recipient shall be enrolled as a full-time student (12-hours minimum) in good standing at Texas A&M University for the duration of the scholarship except during the final semester before graduation in which the 12-hour minimum will be waived.
4. Scholarship recipients will be notified in May by email at the email address provided on the application.
5. Scholarship awards will be presented at the May 17, 2010 Howdy Party of the Fort Bend Aggie Moms' Club. Recipients are strongly encouraged to arrange their schedules in order to be present at this meeting.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Please complete the attached application in full. No resumes will be accepted.

Please make sure all documentation required under **Application Procedure** is either enclosed or will be postmarked by the deadline.

- ____ 1. Enclose ONE signed and completed copy of the **Biographical Information Cover Sheet**.
- ____ 2. Enclose the **ORIGINAL and FOUR (4) COPIES of the completed Scholarship Application**. Last four digits of the applicant's University Identification Number must appear in the upper right hand corner of each page of the original and all four copies, including the responses to questions.

- ____ 3. **One official transcript from Texas A&M University Office of Admissions and Records that includes the Fall 2009 semester.** The official transcript may be (1) enclosed with the application (from the Registrar and sealed in its own envelope) or (2) sent directly from the Registrar to the address given below. Please allow enough time to insure postmark date on or before the deadline of February 8, 2010.
- ____ 4. **Letter of recommendation** may be enclosed or mailed directly to the address given below. In either case, the envelope of the letter of recommendation must be sealed with the author's signature written across the sealed envelope. It must also be postmarked or received no later than the scholarship deadline of February 8, 2010. Give the writer of the recommendation sufficient time to write this letter.
- ____ 5. Mail your completed application to the following address:

OR, applications may be hand delivered to the Scholarship Chairman on or before February 8, 2010.

An acknowledgement will be sent to you at the email address provided on the application within ten days of receipt of completed application including transcript and letter of recommendation. Note that this must be accomplished **within** the February 8, 2010 deadline.

Incomplete or late applications will NOT be considered.
